The aim and the objectives of the Association are to unite Lithuanian researchers in education in their efforts of developing educational research, to spread and to implement the progressive educational experience by developing co-operation with other National Educational Research Associations.

LERA'S MAIN ACTIVITIES IN 1999

- LERA applied for membership in the European Educational Research Association and joined EERA in February 1999.
- The Association has developed and approved in its Annual General Meeting the Guidelines to Educational Research. This document, based on the Postgraduate Training Guidelines of Economic and Social Research Council (UK), states the Association's position regarding the standards of educational research, the requirements to researchers' competence, and the standards of degree education.

- In November 1998, in co-operation with Kaunas University of Technology, LERA held the Second National Conference of Doctoral Students in Education and their Supervisors.
- The Association has published two newsletters which were distributed to its members and other researchers in education and Lithuanian educational institutions. The first issue of the newsletter included the list of the journals which are cited in the Social Sciences Citation Index with purpose to encourage the researchers to submit their articles to these publications. The second issue of the newsletter was completely devoted to the guidelines to Educational Research aiming to initiate a nationwide academic discussion of this document.
- The Executive Council has informed the Science Council of Lithuania, the key Government body dealing with science, about the establishment of LERA, and has offered its members' expertise on various educational issues.
- Jointly with the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences, LERA members organised a seminar for the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences.
- The Educational Management Committee organised a seminar to researchers and students in education.
